**POLICY # 8**

**1.0 POLICY STATEMENT**

Henderson Lake Golf Course stipulates annual dues playing privileges.

**2.0 REGULATIONS**

2.1 Playing Privileges

2.1.1 ADULTS AND SENIORS

2.1.1.1 May play any time the golf course is open as defined by their annual dues.

2.1.2 JUNIORS

2.1.2.1 Can play on weekends and statutory holidays. Course access may be restricted at the discretion of the Head Professional.

2.1.3 ALL OTHER PATRONS

2.1.3.1 Full playing privileges and clubhouse access.

**3.0 PROCEDURE**

3.1 Booking Privileges

3.1.1 All annual dues patrons and public have 7-day advanced booking privileges.

2.1 Starting Play

2.1.1 Players must register and check with the starter located in the Pro shop to obtain approval to start play at the 1st tee.

2.1.2 Play cannot commence from the 10<sup>th</sup> tee without permission of the starter in the pro shop.

2.2 Practicing

2.2.1 Practice is not permitted on the course except where designated as practice areas or when accompanied on the course by a proshop representative as part of a golf lesson.

2.2.2 Unsupervised practice is limited to the practice areas east of the parking lot.

## Policy 8 – Course Rules - 2023

2.2.3 Pro shop staff have priority in using the practice area for lessons.

2.2.4 Practicing players must give priority to playing patrons and will be held liable for hitting into players who are in the practice area as part of their game.

### 2.3 Course Etiquette

2.3.1 Players must be considerate of other golfers particularly when dealing with language, offensive behavior and hitting intentionally into other golfers and club staff.

2.3.2 Abuse of club staff will be dealt with severely according to the Club's policy.

2.3.3 Players must repair their divots, repair their ball marks on the green and rake the bunkers after use.

2.3.4 Players must follow all signs and directions on the golf course.

2.3.5 Power carts are to be kept away from the greens as marked or if no markers, at least 30 feet away from the green in all directions.

2.3.6 Pull carts should not be pulled between the green and all hazards except where permitted.

2.3.7 Players must not litter.

2.3.8 Players should know and understand the rules of golf.

2.3.9 Players must show proper etiquette and consideration by allowing faster groups to play through them if a hole is open in front of them.

2.3.10 No alcohol can be consumed on the course unless purchased from the Clubhouse or other facilities on the course.

### 2.4 Players Liability

2.4.1 Players will be held liable for any damage to course property. Players must report any such incident to the Pro Shop as soon as possible.

2.4.2 Players will be held liable for any injury to other people caused by any action of that player. Any such incident must be reported to the Pro Shop as soon as possible.

2.4.3 Players hitting outside of the course boundaries will be held liable for any injury to the public or damage to property. Any such incident must be reported to the Pro Shop as soon as possible.
